## Nifty way to move, edit or delete photos on your iPhone with your Mac!!

The iPhone is one heck of a good camera. So good that it is way too easy to end up with a camera roll that contains hundreds if not thousands of pictures that we took trying to get that perfect picture!

I have good intentions to get in there and delete the ones that I don't want, but somehow just never get around to actually doing it.

The result? Over 12,000 pictures on my phone that I don't want or need.

Here is a solution that I really like. It's called Airmount and it is a two part solution. You download an app from the App store on the phone. You then download the companion app for your Mid-2012 or later Mac running macOS 10.11 (el Capitan) and install it.

Then you make sure that both your Mac and your iPhone have Bluetooth and WiFi turned on and are both on the same WiFi network. Airmount "lives" in the top bar of your Mac, so to invoke it, just click on it's icon and if your iPhone is nearby you can select it. The phone will ask for permission to connect to your Mac. Once you grant that permission, you see a Finder window with folders that contain the pictures on your iPhone. Just click on the folder that you want to look at and you are set.
